

CPCDE3016 Identify hazards on demolition sites and apply risk management strategies



Prerequisite: CPCWHS2001 Apply WHS requirements, policies and procedures in the construction industry

Demolition work is a high-risk activity. The NSW licensing scheme aims to protect workers and others by making sure that people who carry out demolition work have the training and experience to do it safely.

The NSW Government is moving demolition licensing into the WHS Regulation 2017, where it will better align with other types of licensing schemes for high-risk work in NSW.

New mandatory requirements for demolition workers come into effect on 25 March 2025.
