

**Course** **Identify, Locate & Protect Underground Services (RIICCM202D)**

**Target** Currently employed workers who are required to identify, locate & protect underground services in preparation for civil construction work.

**Course Profile** *Nationally accredited* training that provides participants with the knowledge & skills required to identify, locate & protect underground services in preparation of a site for construction work. Course content aligns to harmonised WHS legislation, codes of practice & guidance material.



### Topic Overview

♣ **Plan & prepare** – compliance documents including legislation, site rules, SWMS, emergency & environmental plans, signage, plant, tools/equipment selection & serviceability, DBYD search & location determination.



♣ **Locate underground services** – consultation with site owners & service/utility owners to obtain relevant location details, emergency & other requirements, visual &/or physical recognition of services/utilities, selection of appropriate plant/ techniques for excavation searches, protection, movement & support of services, incident reporting for near misses/actual damage as required by law and asset owner.

♣ **Clean up** – project/site requirements for clean up, inspection, maintenance and storage of plant, tools & equipment & materials, waste recycling and/or disposal.

**On Completion** On successful completion of knowledge & practical assessment tasks participants will be issued with a nationally accredited **Statement of Attainment & wallet size card.**
