

Verification of Competency (VOC) Assessments

To address new harmonised legislation, Principal Contractors are now requiring VOC assessments for operators of plant and equipment prior to job commencement.

- Cranes (CV, CN, C2, C6)

- Scaffolding (SB, SI, SA)

LOAD SHIFTING / PLANT

- Backhoe/Skidsteer
- Excavator
- Front End Loader
- Skid Steer
- EWP <11m / Scissor Lift
- Telehandler
- Roller / Dumper
- Scraper

Prepare for your VOC assessment by referring to any relevant learning materials, guides or national assessment instruments.

On the day of VOC assessments you need to:

- ✓ Show evidence of ID, Certification (past or current) or prior training you have completed
- ✓ Complete a theory & practical assessment to verify current competency

On completion, you will be deemed either COMPETENT (C) or Not Yet Competent (NYC).

If NYC, identified gaps can be addressed by refresher training.
